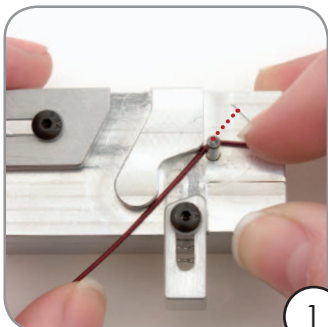
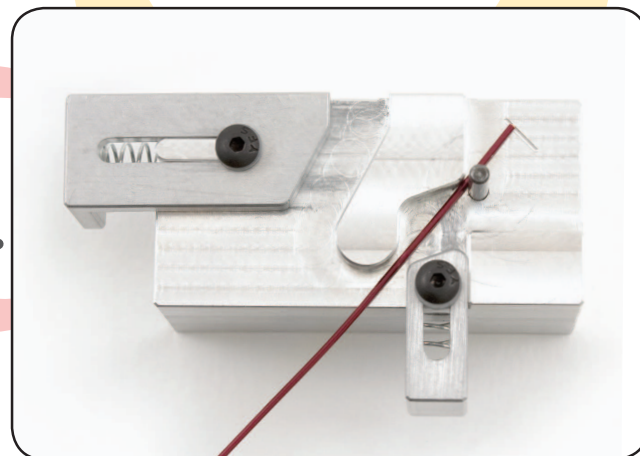


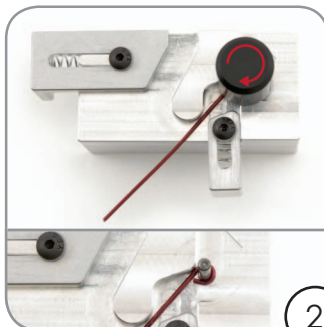
Essentials :

- 20 gauge copper wire - or
- 1 mm aluminum wire
- Fish hook maker (2801-0300)
- Wire cutter
- Steel block and hammer (optional)
- Round nose pliers (optional)
- Wire rounder tool



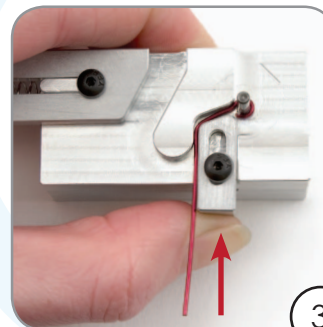
Cut a 5 cm. length of wire. Place one end in line with the line indicated on the Fish-hook maker. Using your index finger, curve the wire slightly towards you.

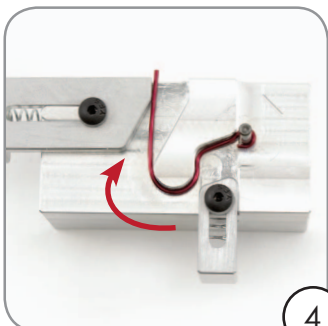
Place the large peg in place, and then rotate it clockwise to form a loop. To add a bead, eliminate this step. After Step 5, add the bead and form the ring manually with the round-nose pliers.

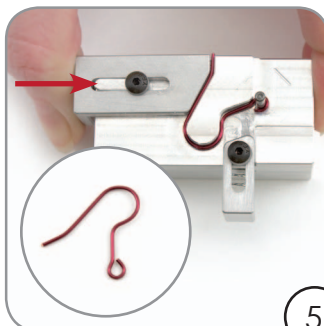
Push in the small piston.

Guide the wire around the round part of the tool.

Push the large piston to guide the wire to obtain the hook shape. The small piston can be used to hold the wire in its place. Cut any excess wire, if necessary. To make your hooks more comfortable to wear, use the wire rounder to round off the sharp tip of the wire.

Lightly hammering the rounded part of the earring hook will make it stronger, and keep it from straightening with the weight of the beads.



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
