Netting Stitch



MATERIALS:

3 m | Weaving thread

... Round beads 2 to 4 mm (small)

or seed beads #10

... Round beads 4 to 7 mm (medium)

... Various beads 8 à 12 mm (large)

1 Scissors

1 | Stringing needle


1 | Clasp

1 Extension chain or junp ring

Glue



Preparation:



1- Choose the size and color of your beads. To create the base of your stitching project, it is recommended to use small round beads (2 to 4 mm) or Czech seed beads (#10). The hole of the beads must be big enough so that a needle can be threaded in many times.


A few larger beads will complete your jewelry beautifully.




2- Decide on the color and type of thread to work with based on the look you want for your jewelry. Wild Fire thread makes the stitching tight and will stay firm for a longer period of time. For a softer stitching, use a standard stringing thread (F).

Cut approximately 3 m of thread and insert your needle up to one third of the length. tiers de la longueur.


* Stringing:




3-String on 10 small beads and then thread counter-clockwise in bead 7.



4- Add 5 other small beads and thread counter-clockwise in bead 1 in order to form a loop.




5-String on 6 small beads then insert the thread in bead 13.




6- String on 5 small beads, follow with a large bead and then with another small one.

Insert the thread counterclockwise in the large bead (27) and then in the next ones (26, 25 and 24) in order to form a peak.




7- String on 5 small beads and then insert the thread in bead 19.



8-String on 6 small beads, and then insert the thread in bead 31. Add 6 small beads and insert the thread in the third bead you just strung.


Add 5 other small beads and then insert the thread in the fourth bead strung at the beginning of this step.



9-Repeat steps 5 to 8 until you reach the desired length. For the central body of the necklace, you should form approximately 14 peaks.




Finishing:



10- To complete your jewelry, string on the amount of small beads necessary to create half of a neck size (for a necklace). Add an extension chain or a ring.

For more fantasy, starting with the seventh bead from the end, insert the thread back in the last beads in order to form a loop. Thread back counter-clockwise in the other beads of the half neck up to the central part.



11- To embellish and at the same time strengthen your project, add medium size beads to a few of the diamond-shaped design. Follow the pattern illustrated on the left (red lines).

Complete your project by repeating step 10 for the other half of your jewelry using the 30 cm of thread put aside at the beginning. This time, add a clasp and the end.



12-Make 2 double flat knots and cut off the excess thread. Using the tip of a needle, add a drop of glue to strengthen them.
