# Triangle Weave



#### **MATERIALS:**

... | Stringing thread

.. 4 mm Bicone

... | Delica® seed beads (#11)

1 Stringing needle

1 Clasp

1 Scissors

1 Cutters

1 cm | French Wire (optional)

BeadFix glue



## \* Preparation:




1- Decide on the color of your beads. You will need three different colors of bicones and one color of Delica® seed beads.




2-Choose the type and color of your thread based on the beads you will use for your project. Cut off a length of 360 cm and thread it in a needle.

If you are using a fine thread such as Nymo, double it in order to work with two lengths of 360 cm each.



3- If you are working with Wild Fire thread, it is recommended to use a flexible stringing needle. With this type of tool, no need to make a knot: simply block the thread in the needle hole.




4- Referring to the chart on the left, take note that group A will form the central flowers, group B will be the embroidery around the flowers and group C the outline of the jewelry.



If you are short with your thread, stitch until there is more or less 5 cm of loose thread. Don't make a knot! Cut another length of thread and insert it in 10 beads always following the shape of the triangles and it will strengthen your jewelry. The new thread must end where you stopped stitching. You are then ready to continue.


### \* Stringing:

#### **Row 1:**




4- String on your beads in the order B, C and B at 30 cm from the end of the thread. Make a knot at the crossing of the two threads. Do not cut the excess thread.

Insert the thread back in the first B of the above step.




5-String on two A beads.

Insert the thread again in B of the previous step and then in the two A's of the present step.




6-String on beads B and A.

Insert the thread again in A of the previous step and then in B and A of the present step.



7-String on beads A and B.


Insert the thread again in A of the previous step and then in A and B of the present step.



8-String on beads B and C.


Insert the thread again in B of the previous step and then in B of the present step.

#### Row 2:



9-String on beads C and B.

Insert the thread again in B of the previous step and then in C and B of the present step.



10-String on two A beads.

Insert the thread again in B of the previous step and then in the first A of the present step.





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
11-String bead A (green)

Insert the thread again in beads B and A (grey) and then in A of the present step.




12-String on beads B and A.

Insert the thread again in A of the previous step and then in B of the present step.




13-String on bead C

Insert the thread again in beads B of steps 4 and 12 and then in A of the previous step.




### **Row 3:**




14-String on beads A and B.

Insert the thread again in A of step 12 and then in A and B of the present step.




15- String on beads C and B.

Insert the thread again in B, A and A of the previous step.



16-String on beads B and A.

Insert the thread again in A of step 14, then in B and A of the present step and finally in A of step 10.



17- String on bead B.

Insert the thread again in beads A of steps 16 and 10 and then in B of the present step.





18-String on beads B and C.


Insert the thread again in B of the previous step and then in B of the present step.



19-Repeat steps 9 to 18 until you are 5 cm away from the desired length for your project. Complete your stitching doing a Row 2 (steps 9 to 13).

When completing and measuring your jewelry, don't forget to take into account the type of clasp you will use.


### \* Finishing:



20- After completing with a Row 2, make sure that your thread is where the yellow dot is located on the illustration.


String on beads A and C.

Insert the thread again in A of step 12 and then in A of the present step.



21-String on beads C and A.

Insert the thread again in A of the previous step, then in C and A of the present step and finally in A of step 10.




22-String on bead C.

Insert the thread again in A of the previous step, then in A of step 20 and finally in C of the previous step.



23-String on bead C and a piece of French Wire (optional), a clasp and then another bead C. Insert the thread again in C of step 21.

Make two knots and cut off the excess thread. Using the tip of a needle, add a drop of glue.



24- At the other end of your jewelry, take the loose thread and repeat steps 20 to 23. Don't forget to include the other part of the clasp.
