TREND-ABSTRACTART




Abstract Art invades the collections. Added interest comes from an explosion of prints and graphics, polka dots, and stripes

TREND-GALACTICA





The Future is forecast in many collections, whether by shiny, metallic fabrics, structured lines, or by the choice of colours, dominated by silver, grey and white.

TREND - COOL METALLICS



Cool metallic shades of steel grey and graphite are often combined with black in an assortment of shimmery but soft fabrics.



Pastels: Soft colours bring a certain freshness to this season's styles, especially combined with white, black and grey.

Red: Whether scarlet, poppy or grenadine, red adds warmth to any outfit.

Green: Different from what we are used to seeing in the Spring and Summer, we are leaving behind the limes and papaya in favour of a darker green such as emerald, forest, spinach, and even moss green.



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Animal prints are everywhere. Leopard prints are especially popular and snake and giraffe are becoming more evident. Tiger and zebra prints haven't left the scene.

Floral prints (flowers, plants and leaves) add punches of colour to the various collections.

Whimsical fruits are invading our wardrobes, adding a youthful quality to our style.

Butterflies, whether printed or in 3-D, are a playful addition to this year's collections.

TRENDS – DESIGNS & PRINTS



Plaids are ever popular, with **tartans** and **ginghams** taking the center stage.

Stripes are worn in all directions, at times on the same garment. We see all sizes, from very fine to quite large, sometimes in variations on the same theme.

Polka dots are making a comeback, but in different ways than before. The retro style of past seasons give way to dots of varying dimensions and often with bold colours.

Graphic abstract prints are ever-present.

TRENDS-FABRICS



- s Silks and satins.
- 😘 Laces: Celtic, Irish and traditional, almost always white.
- 🗷 Denim, all shades from the palest to the darkest.
- 🗷 Classic fabrics: linen, cotton and lightweight knits.
- Shiny fabrics: lame, sparkling knits, sequins, etc.
- Seathers, leather and furs. Leather is present in bright colours such as red, violet, green and sometimes, even in pastels.

TRENDS-JEWELRY



Jewelry is definitely the accessory of the season.


Necklaces are seen in all lengths: from long to short, light and airy to heavy and full, supple or rigid. **Mid-length necklaces** are always popular. Long and light, they are often worn with a matching bracelet. **Short necklaces**, very full, are paired with **massive bracelets**. Back again this year, **chokers** are presented in many styles and materials. The **plastron**, or **breastplate**, is holding its own as stylish fashion statement. Elements to add to necklaces are **pompoms**, **cameos**, **fringe**, **large pendants** and **large chains** in any form or material.

Bangle bracelets are very important, wide, worn alone or with others.

Far from discreet, this year's **earrings** are generously proportioned, both in length and width. Bright colours, such as green, fuchsia and blue are in evidence. Often, no other jewelry is necessary, especially if one's hair is worn up.

Chains are a leading material, mostly gold-coloured but also in black. Natural materials are of the essence: **feathers**, **leather**, **rough jewel stones**, all in natural colours. **Ribbons** and **cloth strips** are entwined to form large masses.

Inevitable are the **metallic** colours, **black**, **grey** and **natural colours**. **Vibrant colours** are used in small quantities to give much needed contrast and depth, especially when coordinated with the clothing.



TRENDS-MENSWEAR



Menswear is divided into two categories.

Classic

Cotton and linen, traditional fabrics for summer, are seen in white, beige, grey and black. Pants are cut narrow, either straight-leg or closer to the ankle. Shorter ¾ -length are worn with sandals. The style is more relaxed, with neckties becoming scarce.

Eccentric

The fashion-forward man wears pastel colours (yellow, pink) or more striking colours, such as blue lagoon, sea-green, orange

and red. Splashy patterns (skulls, flowers and graphics) and fringe are also evident in this season's collections.
