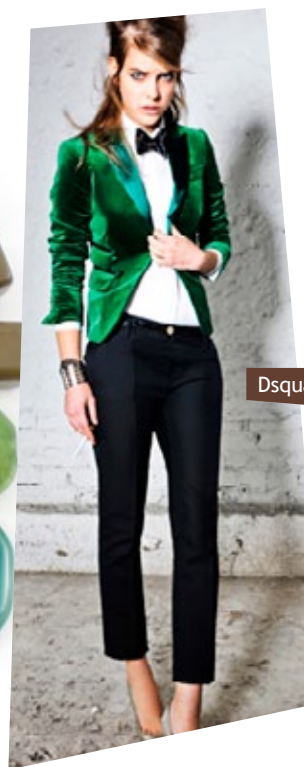
Red

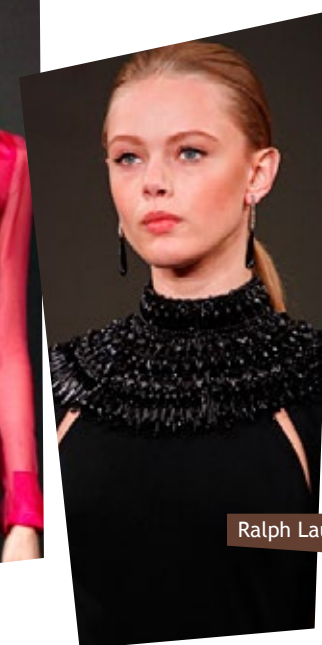

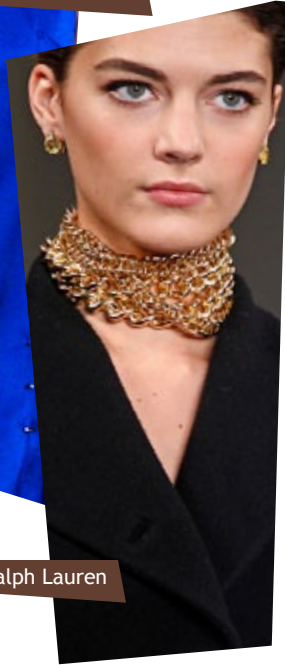
Necklaces

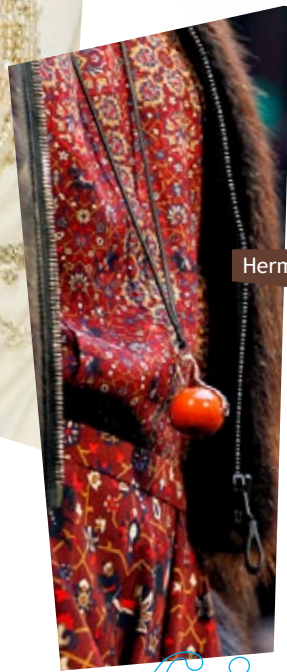
Necklaces (sequel)

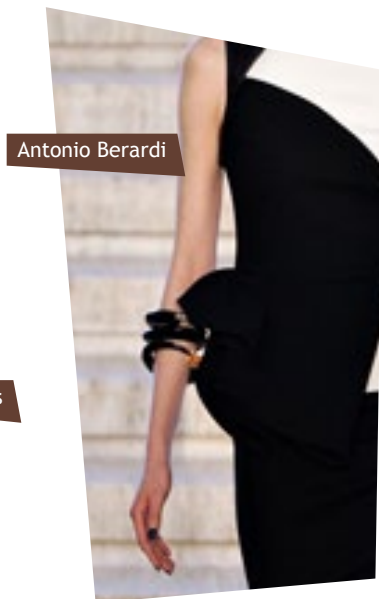
Earrings

Richness

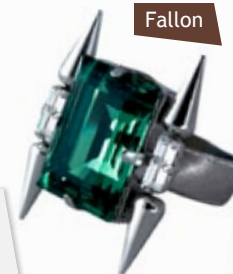
