

Essentials :

- Waxed cotton cord or rat tail
- Connectors*
- Scissors
- Flat pliers
- Glue



*There are several types of connectors and their purpose depends on the width and the number of cords employed in the process.



"U" connector



Insert the cord in the connector and fold the flaps of the connector one on the other using the flat pliers.

Use bigger connectors for multi-strands jewels.

Cord connector



Glue the tip of the cord and insert it in the connector.

By using flat pliers, squeeze the cord with the connector's last row.

Multi-strands connector



Form a knot at both ends of all cords before aligning them.

One by one, insert each strand's knots in the connector in order to close the connector's cover.



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
