

Essentials :

- 1 swivel trigger clasp (1706-0300)
- 1 split ring 28 mm (1706-0212)
- 2 jump rings 7 mm
- 2 to 3 eyelet pins
- 10 to 12 flat head pins
- 1 square ring (1110-6015-02)
- 4 cylinders (1110-6005-02)
- 3 rectangles (1110-6004-02)
- 8 to 10 assorted beads
- 1 pair of round pliers
- 2 pairs of flat pliers
- 1 pair of cutting pliers



Slip the swivel trigger clasp on the split ring. Put aside for later use.

1



Thread the beads of your central piece. Use flat pliers to practice a 45° bend on your pin and roughly form the eyelet.

2



Keep 8 mm of your pin and cut the exceeding part. Pinch and twist the extremity by the inside to finish the eyelet.

3



Use this last technique to create your charms.

4



With your two pairs of flat pliers, thread your charms on a 7 mm jump ring. Close the ring by attaching it to an eyelet of the central piece.

5



Repeat to link up the other eyelet of the central piece and the split ring.
