

MAKING A MOULD FOR POLYMER CLAY

Materials:

- Mold maker (2901-0307)
- Polymer clay
- 1 oven-proof plate
- 1 super slicer for polymer clay
- Objects to form the moulds
- 1 beading awl or sharp-pointed tool







Slice the desired amount of clay to make your mould. Make a ball, then flatten to 1/4 inch thick.



Carefully press the objects into the clay.



Carefully withdraw the object, using the awl if necessary. Place the mould on oven-proof plate.

Bake at 275 °F for 15 minutes. Take the mould from the oven and let cool on the plate.



Form a ball with the polymer clay, then press it into the mould. Be certain that all parts of the mould are filled.



Carefully remove the clay. Cut away the surplus clay with the super slicer. Use a pointed tool for the smaller details.



Bake the shapes following the instructions on the package of your polymer clay.
