

## MATERIALS:

1 or +	Feathers of your choice
...	Connector(s)
...	Crimp(s)
...	Various beads
1	Scissors or cutters
1	Flat nose pliers
1	Crimping pliers
...	E6000 glue or
	G-S Hypo Cement glue



## Preparation:



1- Choose the color and type of feathers you wish to integrate in your creation.

2- Choose the type of connector(s) according to the style you want to give to your jewelry.

To get the best results, you should first visualize your jewelry in order to plan how to position the hole of the connector with the feather. This will reflect its style once the feather is added to your creation.

## Finishing:



### a-Snake chain connector:

Dip the end of the feather in glue and then insert it in the connector.

Using the crimp bead cutters, squeeze the lower part of the connector.

### b-Cord connector:

Dip the end of the feather in glue and then insert it in the connector. You can leave it like that, or slightly squeeze the last row of the connector using flat nose pliers. Be careful not to damage the feather.

**c-«U» connector:**  
Insert the feather in the connector and then close up the sides on each other using flat nose pliers.



**d-Crimp:**  
To add feathers on Tigertail thread, string on a crimp bead. Insert the end of the feather in the bead and then squeeze it with the crimp bead pliers. Cut off the excess feathers and add a crimp cover.



If you want to add a personal touch of fantasy to your creation, just insert any beads of your choice.

You can use them to hide a connector or to give your jewelry a funky style. Just add them wherever you want on the feathers.
